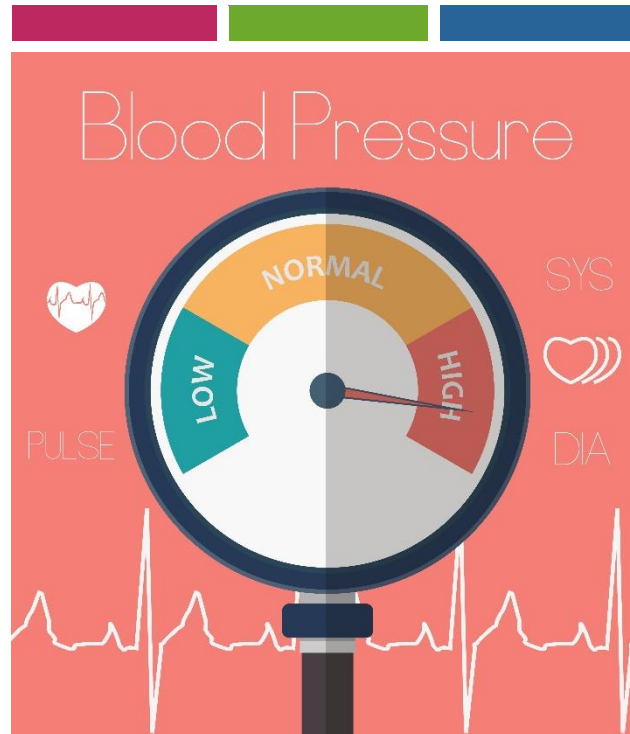
1. Regrow your own hair in 3 months

Hypertension Combination Therapy

For most patients, combination antihypertensive therapy should include an ACE I, ARB, thiazide diuretic or calcium channel blocker.

Patients with chronic kidney disease who also have proteinuria should be prescribed an ACE I or ARB as part of combination therapy.

Note: The combination of an ACE I and an ARB should be avoided.

Injection Therapies

Injection/infusion solution therapy is a technique used to treat joint/body pain in all parts of the body. This may be the last line of treatment before surgery is recommended. We offer injections for the upper and lower extremities, neck and back.

Trigger Points Treated

1. Shoulders
1. Elbow median nerve blocks
2. Carpal tunnel, hands and wrists
3. Back and neck, head and neck
4. Sub-occipital nerve blocks
5. Knees and hips
6. Trochanteric bursitis
7. Plantar fasciitis
8. Ankles and toes
